Alaska USA Foundation gives \$10,000 to Greater Hope Foundation

Apple Valley, California – The Alaska USA Foundation has donated \$10,000 to the Greater Hope Foundation to support the Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) program, which provides a treatment modality at a local counseling center. The program is being launched to fulfill a need for quality counseling for families.

The donation will help the program launch in the Inland Empire area of San Bernardino County. PCIT will focus counseling support on families with children ages two to seven with significant disruptive behaviors. The treatment will consist of hour-long sessions, typically over a period of 12 to 20 weeks.
