**Alaska USA members and Alaska USA Foundation raise more than \$77,000
in annual food drive**

Anchorage, Alaska – Alaska USA Federal Credit Union members contributed \$77,900 to support community food banks during the annual Cash for Cans food drive.

The credit union and the Alaska USA Foundation teamed up for the fundraiser, collecting cash donations at Alaska USA branches. Alaska branches collected \$49,400, which will benefit the Food Bank of Alaska in Anchorage, Fairbanks Community Food Bank, Palmer Food Bank, Kenai Peninsula Food Bank, MatSu Food Bank, Kodiak Island Food Bank, Homer Food Pantry, Southeast Alaska Food Bank in Juneau, the Salvation Army in Ketchikan, and the Lions Club in Bethel.
