## Do more with an Alaska USA Business Debit Card

Your Business Visa Debit Card is linked to your Alaska USA checking account. With your card, you can also:

- Transfer funds to and from business checking, and access money market accounts at designated ATMs.
- Use in place of petty cash to help track small purchases.
- Make online purchases for your business 24/7.
- Use it for convenience during business trips; it's accepted at millions of retail locations worldwide.
- Have recurring business costs deducted from your account.

## Enjoy a free card with added benefits

Business Visa Debit Cards are free. Plus, you can take advantage of the following cost-savings:

**55,000 surcharge-free ATMs** – Avoid cash withdrawal fees by using any Alaska USA or Allpoint ATM worldwide. To find the ATM closest to you, refer to the ATM locator on the Alaska USA app or at [alaskausa.org/atm](http://alaskausa.org/atm).

**No point-of-sale transaction fee** – Many financial institutions will charge a fee whenever you use your debit card at a merchant location. Alaska USA does not charge any fees.

## Giving employees access

- Each account can have multiple cards for employees who need them. However, they must be authorized signers on your business account.
- When an employee leaves your company, the business debit card is still valid as long as the cardholder is still an authorized signer on the account. Once you remove a signer from the account, an associated debit card is immediately closed. However, you should still retrieve the physical card from the employee.

## Keep your information secure

All employees who carry Visa Debit Cards tied to your business account should keep these tips in mind:

- If a Visa Debit Card is lost or stolen, notify Alaska USA immediately for zero liability on purchases.
- In order to protect the account, cardholders should memorize their Personal Identification Number (PIN) instead of writing it down.
